



Researchers are calling on all European Farmers to take part in a survey on pain and disease in animals

The survey aims to understand the attitudes and viewpoints of the people who look after livestock on a daily basis. The project looks into how farm workers feel about pain in their animals. It provides an opportunity for farmers to have their say on what can be an emotive and poorly understood area of animal health management. In particular the survey aims to identify what constraints farmers feel under, in relation to pain relief provision, for instance, financial or practical limitations.

It is vital that farmers have an opportunity to express their views and any concerns they have regarding the identification and control of pain in their animals.

The questionnaire has been developed as part of an EU-funded project, Animal Welfare Indicators (AWIN). The AWIN research team want to hear from as many European livestock, poultry and fish farmers as possible.
